Semester Course Grade Calculations:

Full Year Course Grade Calculations:

*The full year grade is calculated by averaging the four marking period (MP) grades.
If one of the four marking period grades is missing, the final grade will be based on the average of the three available grades. If more than one marking period grade is missing, the final grade will appear as M (Missing).*
