### **i.e. and e.g.**

The notation *i.e.* typically introduces a rewording or clarification. The etymology is Latin: *i.e.* stands for *id est*, meaning *that is*.

The notation *e.g.* introduces one or more examples that illustrate an explanation. The etymology is Latin: *e.g.* stands for *exempli gratia*, meaning *for example*.

Both are preceded by a comma.
