How severe are MCPS employee injuries and illnesses?

Occupational injury/illness severity can be evaluated by looking at the number of cases resulting in lost workdays, job restrictions, and job transfer and the total number of lost workdays, days of job restriction, and days of job transfer.

DART (Days Away, Restricted, Transferred) Rate

 Total cases involving days away from work, days of restricted work activity, or job transfer per 100 fulltime employees

No. of lost workday, job transfer, or restriction cases * 200,000 / Total hours worked by employees

Severity Rate

Total lost workdays, days of restricted work activity, or job transfer per 100 full-time employees

No. of lost workdays, days of job transfer, or restriction * 200,000 / Total hours worked by employees

¹ This represents the total hours worked in a calendar year by 100 full-time employees: 2,000 hours for 100 employees (2,000 * 100 = 200,000).

What is MCPS' DART rate?

Systemwide DART Rate (CY23)

No. of lost workday, job transfer, or restriction cases * 200,000 / Total hours worked by employees =

546 cases * 200,000 / 36,746,443.26 = 3.0

3.0 lost workday, job transfer, or restriction cases per 100 full-time employees

What is MCPS' severity rate?

Systemwide Severity Rate (CY23)

Total lost workdays, days of restricted work activity, or job transfer * 200,000 / Total hours worked by employees =

24,400 days * 200,000 / 36,746,443.26 = 132.8
