Dear Parents,

We wish you and your child a very successful new school year. Montgomery County Public Schools transportation makes every attempt to transport all students safely to and from school.

It is a MCPS regulation (EEA-RA, II, D, 5c, 2, c), that special education students must have a responsible parent/ guardian greet them at the bus stop daily. However, some parents are unable to provide someone to meet older students or feel that a student is responsible to depart without an escort.

We must have your signature and permission to allow your special needs student to leave the bus stop unescorted. Without your permission, or if you are not at the bus stop when your special education student arrives, the child will be returned to the school and you will be responsible for transportation. If your child is returned to school three (3) times, Child Protective Services will be notified and bus service suspended pending a hearing.

Please return the signature part of this form to your driver who will give it to the transportation supervisor.
