 **MARYLAND COMPREHENSIVE ASSESSMENT PROGRAM (MCAP)**  - Any student in grades 3, 4, and 5 who was absent or unavailable for testing during the regular testing period will take the MCAP assessment for English/Language Arts and Mathematics during the make-up period, May 19th - May 23rd.

How to help your child/Reminders:

- Get a good night's rest the night before
 - Eat a healthy breakfast at home or plan to eat the school-provided breakfast
 - Be on time on the day of testing - Students who arrive at school late will not be allowed into the classroom during a testing session and will be required to test on a make-up day.
 - **NO CELL PHONES/WATCHES/Bluetooth Headphones** - Personal mobile devices, such as cell phones/watches/tablets or Bluetooth-enabled headphones, are NOT permitted during the assessment administration. Use of these items during testing is a violation of test security and is strictly prohibited.

Additional Boundary Study Engagement Sessions Soon!!

(Sessions will include maps with initial boundary options and a tool to use your home address to discover any changes to school assignments.)

If you missed it, MCPS will host additional boundary study engagement sessions. We invite you to participate in the upcoming engagement sessions focused on the reopening of Charles W. Woodward High School, the opening of Crown High School, and the expansion of Damascus High School. These sessions will cover the initial options for each study and share how potential changes may affect families with middle and high school students beginning in the 2027 school year.
