**Literacy SMARTIE Goals**

School Literacy Goal (This represents the overall **student achievement** of an underserved focus group(s). Achieving this goal will be essential in order to accomplish the District goal for all students, and address the root cause of inequity at the school level):

- By June 2025, the percentage of Kindergarten - 2nd grade Hispanic Candlewood Scholars meeting the academic milestone for DIBELS (Spring Composite Score) will increase from 68.9% to 79%.
- By June 2025, the percentage of 3rd - 5th grade Hispanic Candlewood Scholars meeting the academic milestone for NWEA MAP-R (Spring RIT to Reading Score) will increase from 58.3% to 73%.

**Math SMARTIE Goals**

School Math Goal (This represents the overall **student achievement** of an underserved focus group(s). Achieving this goal will be essential in order to accomplish the District goal for all students, and address the root cause of inequity at the school level):

- By June 2025, the percentage of Kindergarten - 2nd grade Hispanic Candlewood Scholars meeting the academic milestone for NWEA MAP-P (Spring RIT Score) will increase from 58.62% to 68%.
- By June 2025, the percentage of 3rd - 5th grade Hispanic Candlewood Scholars meeting the academic milestone for NWEA MAP-M (Spring RIT Score) will increase from 62.5% to 70%.

**Culture/Climate SMARTIE Goals**

- By June 2025, the percentage of Candlewood Staff that report feeling quite and extremely comfortable discussing race/ethnicity-related topics with their colleagues will increase from 76.5% to 80%.
- By June 2025, the percentage of Hispanic Candlewood Scholars that report feeling they are comfortable asking questions and are encouraged to participate in class will increase from 92% to 98%.
- By June 2025, the percentage of families that disagree with the statement "I feel connected to other adults at my child's school." will decrease from 19.7% to 11%.

**Well-Being SMARTIE Goals**

- By June 2025, there will be a decrease in the chronic absenteeism rate of Hispanic Candlewood Scholars from 25.3% to 20%.
