
As part of the Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS) Drinking Water Testing Program, testing has been completed at your school. One or more drinking water outlets contained lead concentrations at or above the Maryland Department of the Environment Action Level of 5 parts per billion. Drinking water outlets with elevated lead concentrations have been shut down until mitigation actions have been completed.

Attached is the drinking water testing report with results for your school, which contains information about the health effects associated with exposure to lead.
