


# Eagle News - Pre-K

## Literacy

This month, in literacy, we are focusing on the theme: Growing Up Healthy. The students will be learning to demonstrate an understanding of basic features of print and text information. They will learn to recognize upper and lower case letters of the alphabet and letter sounds. Our goal is for all students to be able to identify all 52 letters and their sounds. They

will begin to identify words in a sentence by using snap cubes as each word is said in the sentence. Students will be working in small guided reading groups. We have collected all the data from the Pre-K Progress Reports and we will focus on students' goals for reading.

## Math

This month, in math, the students will identify written numerals 0-20. They will verbally count to 10 by ones and then develop rote counting to 20 by ones. Our goal is to have all students count to 20 and identify all the numerals from 1-20. Students will also be identifying simple shapes, sorting, measuring and comparing lengths. Our goal is to have all students count from 1 to 100. Students will be working in small math groups. We have collected all the data from the Pre-K Progress Reports and we will focus on students' goals for math.
