Thespian e-badge! Opens July 6 and closes August 31.

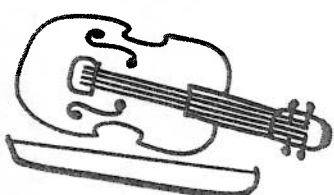
Badge 3: Arts for All
