







Sick Kids:

When to Stay Home from School:

FEVER A temperature of 100.4° or higher	COUGHING THAT WON'T STOP Or other problems with breathing	DIARRHEA OR VOMITING Within the past 24 hours	RASH Body rash with itching and/or fever	HEAD LICE Itchy head, active head lice	EYE INFECTION Eye is red and oozing a yellow or green discharge
					
When to Return to School: Fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medication such as ibuprofen or acetaminophen	When to Return to School: Cough is mild and infrequent and evaluated by doctor if needed	When to Return to School: Free from diarrhea and/or vomiting for at least 24 hours and evaluated by doctor if needed	When to Return to School: Free from rash, itching or fever and evaluated by doctor if needed	When to Return to School: After first head lice treatment	When to Return to School: 24 hours after starting antibiotic eye drops or ointment
