

# WYNGATE SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT SMARTIE GOALS

## **Literacy SMARTIE Goals FY 24-25**

#### **District Literacy Goal:**

By the end of the 2024-2025 school year, at least 90% of all students will meet the academic milestone for proficiency in literacy

School Literacy Goal (This represents the overall student achievement of an underserved focus group(s). Achieving this goal will be essential in order to accomplish the District goal for <u>all</u> students, and address the root cause of inequity at the school level):

By the end of the 2024-2025 school year, our Hispanic students will achieve an EOL mark of 90% in Literacy.

Gap Reduction Goal (This represents the individual projected growth for students. Achieving this goal will close gaps between student groups; it reduces predictability in outcomes and supports the achievement of both the school and district goals; accomplishing this is essential to close gaps in student experience and achievement, which will therefore support the school in accomplishing both the school and district goals):

By June 2025, 95% 96% or more of the Kindergarten students will meet the literacy benchmark on DIBELS with a composite score of 420 or higher.

### Math SMARTIE Goals FY 24-25

#### **District Literacy Goal:**

By the end of the 2023-2024 school year, at least 90% of all students will meet the academic milestone for proficiency in math

School Math Goal (This represents the overall student achievement of an underserved focus group(s). Achieving this goal will be essential in order to accomplish the District goal for <u>all</u> students, and address the root cause of inequity at the school level):

By the end of the 2024-2025 school year, our Hispanic students will achieve an EOL mark of 92 % in Math.

Gap Reduction Goal (This represents the individual projected growth for students. Achieving this goal will close gaps between student groups; it reduces predictability in outcomes and supports the achievement of both the school and district goals; accomplishing this is essential to close gaps in student experience and achievement, which will therefore support the school in accomplishing both the school and district goals):

By the end of 2024-2025, at least 60% of Hispanic students will exceed their individual projected growth goals on the Measurement of Academic Progress in math (MAP-P/M) assessment from Fall to Spring.

### Culture/Climate SMARTIE Goals FY 24-25

By June 2025, 90% or more of our students will "agree" or "strongly agree" to the survey question "I feel safe at school."

## Well-Being SMARTIE Goals

By June 2025, we will decrease the percentage of "chronically absent" students from 10% of the overall student population to 7%.
