

Advanced Placement Power Scholars (APPS) Application Information and Instructions 2024-2025

The APPS application will consist of

- 1. Student information
- 2. Teacher Recommendations
- 3. Counselor Documentation (MAP-R RIT Score & Cumulative GPA)

Students are responsible for completing the information of the application. They are also responsible for requesting recommendations from their teachers. The counselors at Rocky Hill, Hallie Wells, and Clarksburg will be contacted directly by the APPS Coordinator in order to obtain GPA and MAP-R information for students who attend those schools. Students who currently attend a school other than those listed above must request this information from their school counselor.

Step One: Student Information

Complete the demographic questions about yourself. Be prepared to include the names of the three teachers you will ask for recommendations.

Step Two: Teacher Recommendation

Contact three CURRENT teachers asking them to complete a recommendation to the program on your behalf. Once they have accepted, send them the link for the google form. Students should ask core content teachers such as English, Math, Science, and Social Studies. Some other courses that may be considered are World Languages and Engineering. Please let them know that they do not need to complete this until December 15th. This should give them more time to get to know you.

Step Three: Counselor Verification

If you do not attend Rocky Hill, Hallie Wells, or Clarksburg, contact your current school counselor and request they complete the google form to include your MAP-R RIT score and cumulative GPA.

Important dates to remember

September 26th - the APPS application opens November 1st- the APPS application closes December 15th- teacher recommendations and counseling information is due January 10th- decision letters are emailed
