REMINDER! The Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS) and the National Association for College Admission Counseling (NACAC) 2025 College Fair has been announced! MCPS college fair field trip dates are Tuesday, April 8 and Wednesday, April 9. There will be evening hours on Tuesday, April 8 from 6:30 pm until 8 pm.

Class of 2026 ONLY: The Northwest High School Field Trip date is Tuesday, April 8. Students <u>must</u> complete <u>and</u> return the Field Trip <u>Permission Form and</u> complete the <u>NACAC College Fair Registration</u>. Students will depart from the cafeteria at 9:45 am and return to school around 12 pm. The Permission Form must be signed by parent or guardian and returned to the College Career Information Center (Room 126) no later than student lunch on March 28. Field trip forms will only be accepted before school or at lunch. Forms will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis until all reserved bus seats are filled.



SCHOLARSHIP: The Marjay D. Anderson Trailblazer Scholarship (MDATS) was established by the Blue Horizon Foundation in 2021. The MDATS is awarded annually to a graduating FEMALE HIGH SCHOOL SENIOR entering an accredited U.S. college or university full-time for training in a Science, Technology, Engineering or Mathematics (STEM) career in the fall of the year. The applicant must have a 3.0 or higher cumulative grade point average (GPA), and be a permanent resident of the Washington, District of Columbia area (including neighboring Maryland and Virginia). The student must attend a college or university in the United States. The award will be paid directly to the institution. <u>SCHOLARSHIP:</u> <u>Dunkin Scholarship.</u> **SENIORS.** Available to students who plan to enroll in a part-time or full-time undergraduate course of study at an accredited two-year or four-year college, university-technical school in Fall 2025. Scholarship recipients will be selected on the basis of "well-rounded" character: positive academic record, demonstrated leadership, commitment to school and community activities, and experience in a work environment. <u>SCHOLARSHIP:</u> The Association For Federal Information Resources Management (AFFIRM) STEM Scholarship. AFFIRM is a non-profit, volunteer, educational organization whose overall purpose is to improve the management of information, related systems, and resources, within the Federal government. AFFIRM's scholarship program supports STEM educational opportunities for students attending District of Columbia, Maryland, and Virginia accredited institutions. AFFIRM annually determines the dollar amount of scholarships based on financial contributions received by the organization.

• The AFFIRM Annual Scholarship – Both high school seniors and current undergraduate students are eligible for this scholarship. The applicant must be pursuing a college/university degree with a major in computer sciences, information sciences, or any STEM-related field.
