- 3. Slang/Street Terms for the drug (at least 5)
- 4. How is it administrated (smoked, injected, etc.)
- 5. What are the PHYSICAL effects of the drug? BOTH long term and short term effects (How does it affect the body?)
- 6. What are the PSYCHOLOGICAL (mind) effects of the drug?
- 7. What are the withdrawal symptoms associated with the drug, if any? Treatment available?
- What is the rate of teens using the drug currently in the country?

## **Design of PowerPoint Presentation:**

- 1. Creative Title Include names and period number
- 2. At least 10 slides, including the title and word cited page
- 3. At least 4-5 Pictures www.picsearch.com
- 4. Easy to follow not too wordy!
- 5. Free of grammar and spelling errors

## **Cited Sources:**

- A minimum of 3 sources must be used for this project. One of the sources should be a resource book
- Sources should be cited, using Noodle Tools, on the last slide of the PowerPoint presentation
