

Career clusters are a way of grouping careers with common features and skills. Careers grouped into the same cluster typically require similar and training. Exploring clusters can be a useful way to find a good career match, especially if you have general areas of interest but are not sure specific careers match those interests. Career clusters can also help you better understand how your coursework in school can prepare you for types of careers.




