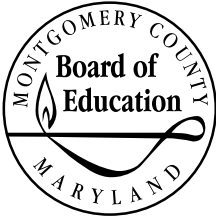

# Definitions

An abbreviation is any shortened form of a word. For example: etc. for etcetera, and Aug. for August. Acronyms and initialisms are types of abbreviations.

**Acronyms are abbreviations that can be pronounced as words.** For example: ACT-SO (Academic, Cultural, Technological, and Scientific Olympics), BRAC (Base Realignment and Closure), and COSA (Change of School Assignment).

**Initialisms are abbreviations not pronounced as words.** For example: MCPS (Montgomery County Public Schools), AYP (Adequate Yearly Progress), and SLMP (School Library Media Programs).

## HOW TO USE MCPS ABBREVIATIONS IN YOUR DOCUMENT

- Spell out the name at first mention, with the abbreviation in parentheses (except in the subject line).
- Use the abbreviation at any further mention of the name in the document.
- Do not put a period after each letter in an abbreviation, except—
  - when you are referring to a person’s academic credentials (Kara Smith, Ph.D.; Justin Cortez, Ed.D.; and Greta Banks, B.A.);
  - with abbreviations that end in a lowercase letter (p. [page], e.g., a.m., p.m., Dr., Ms., and Rev.); and
  - when you refer to the United States in a descriptive manner (U.S. schools, U.S. students).

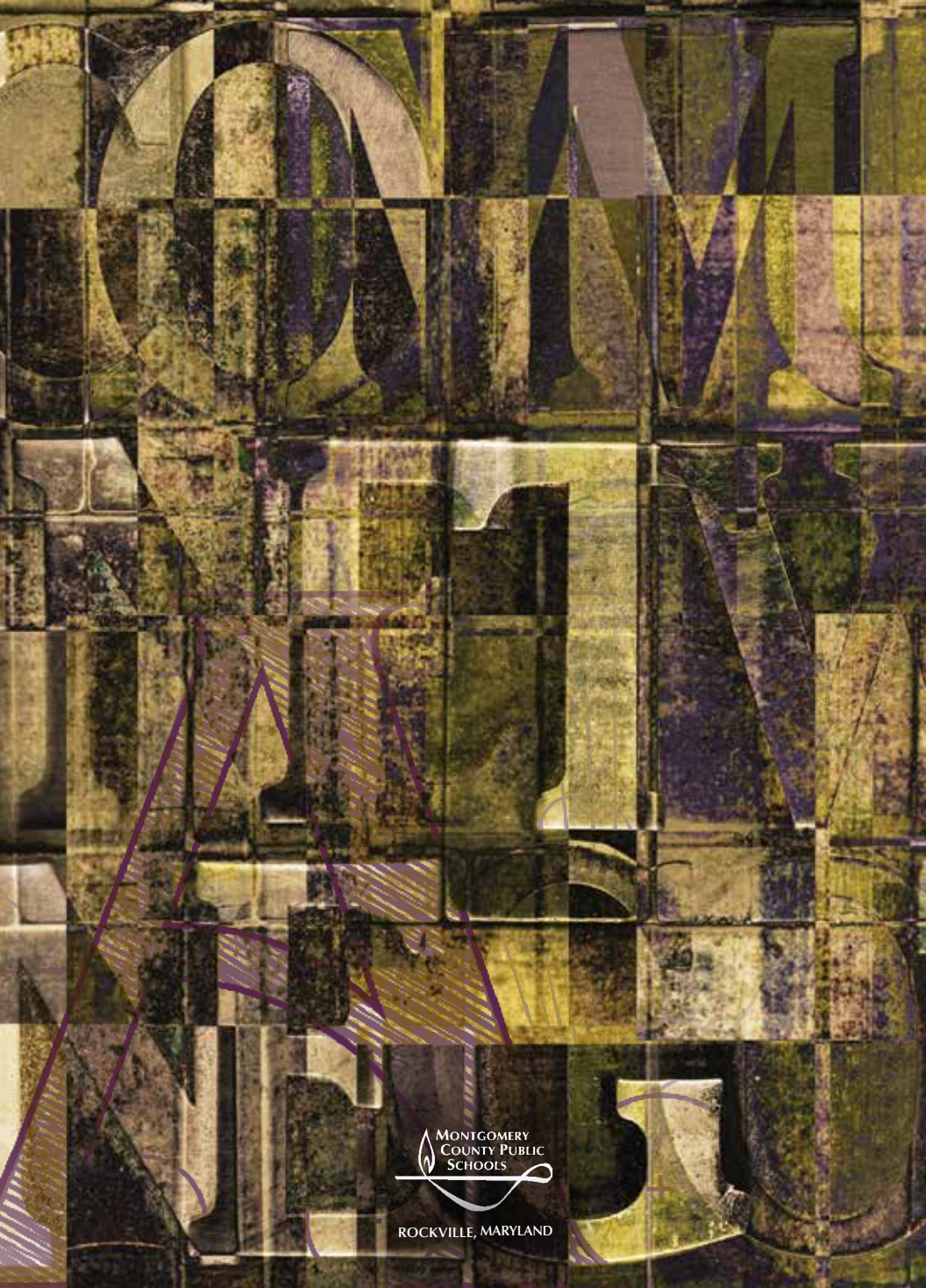


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
